Are Black and White Colours?

- During exploration of the topic “Art – Are black and white colours?” we looked at color and its form and how these simple concepts bring an awareness of children’s ways of expressing and exploring a topic.
 - We revisited the idea that every art medium encourages different ways of thinking, discovering and learning through discovering different approaches to art materials and learning how to nurture the curiosity and “live inquiry” in the child through process and questioning.
