Registered license-not-required child care programs in the City of Vancouver were contacted by Westcoast and asked for their monthly full time rates as of December 2020.

At the point of survey, there were 40 registered license-not-required child care, of which 40 (100%) registered license-not-required child care provided fee information.

AVERAGE = Calculated by adding the monthly full time rates and then dividing by the number of family child care responses. MEDIAN = Half the RLNRs have rates that are greater than the median, and half the RLNRs have rates that are less than the median.

INFANT = 6 weeks to 18 months.
TODDLER = 19 months to 3 years.

On September 1, 2018, the Affordable Child Care Benefit replaced the Child Care Subsidy. The new funding will help families with the cost of child care, depending on factors like family size, type of care and household income.
