ANALYSIS: As the table shows, the median full fee increased by \$240 from 2021 to 2022. However, consistent with the change in provincial fee reduction, the difference between the median full fee and reduced fee increased significantly to \$900 in 2022, vs. \$350 in 2021. Consequently, the percentage of reduction more than doubled, from 18% in 2021 to 42% in 2022.

ANALYSIS: As the table shows, the median full fee increased by \$286 from 2021 to 2022. However, consistent with the change in provincial fee reduction, the difference between the median full fee and reduced fee increased significantly to \$826 in 2022, vs. \$350 in 2021. Consequently, the percentage of reduction doubled, from 20% in 2021 to 40% in 2022.

ANALYSIS: As the table shows, the median full fee increased by \$90 from 2021 to 2022. However, consistent with the change in provincial fee reduction, the difference between the median full fee and reduced fee increased significantly to \$545 in 2022, vs. \$101 in 2021. Consequently, the percentage of reduction increased five-fold, from 9% in 2021 to 46% in 2022.
